
## Re: Mobile Phone Coverage in the Weald

Since I wrote to you in November, I'm delighted to report we have made significant progress on our campaign to improve mobile phone coverage across our rural Wealden communities.

To tackle the issues highlighted by our campaign, the Government has announced a landmark legally binding deal with the four major mobile phone networks (Vodafone, O2, EE & Three) to resolve poor signal issues across Kent and the UK.

Under the agreement there will be a guaranteed £5bn investment programme to improve mobile infrastructure by 2017, halving the areas currently blighted by patchy coverage as a result of partial 'not-spots', and reducing complete not-spots by almost two-thirds. The deal will be enforceable by Ofcom, and as a result of the agreement, many areas across Kent will receive better data coverage, some for the first time.

I am also pleased to inform you that we now have a venue for our public meeting with the Minister responsible for our Mobile Networks and Broadband, Ed Vaizey. It will be at the High Weald Academy in Cranbrook at 7pm on February 12<sup>th</sup> 2015. I have invited the four major mobile networks along too, with Vodafone already pledging their attendance.

We have a clear indication of the shape and location of the current signal not-spots thanks to the problem postcodes you have provided (above right), and the meeting will provide the opportunity to explore how this landmark deal will improve coverage in these communities across the Weald.
